## Biliary atresia Infant Stool Colour Cards (ISCCs):

Please continue to order ISCCs through our distributor, VWR, through the same process as ordering dried blood spot cards. Instructions can be found on the <u>Supplies page of our website</u>.

The Point-of-Care card (formally the CCHD card) includes a convenient check box to indicate that the ISCC has been provided to the family. This is an important tool for NSO to monitor uptake and

compliance with ISCC distribution prior to discharge.
